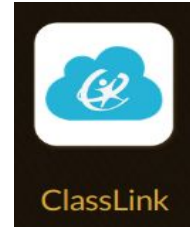
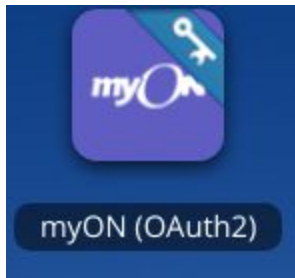


Dear Parents,

The Haverhill School District and myON have partnered to provide the children of Haverhill with a digital library of over 6000 books and news articles. Your child is able to access these books through ClassLink found on the top row of Haverhill's Launchpad.

Your child will use their school username and password to sign on. There is a myON icon that will easily log them into the site. First, they will be given a list of interests to choose from so they can get books based on those interests. Some students will take a quick multiple choice assessment that will determine their lexile and then be brought to a launchpad where they can begin

picking books. Others may be brought to a page that will ask them if they want to link their STAR scores using a *Connect Now* button. After clicking on the button, students will enter their username and password (it's the same for every site and is the one they use to sign onto their Chromebooks) and follow the directions.



Teachers can also assign books and projects but if teachers do not assign these, your child can still begin reading. And the whole family can download their own books!
